

HONOLUA STORE, KAPALUA RESORT FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW: Built in 1929 by pineapple plantation carpenters, The Honolua Store is still a central feature of Kapalua Resort. Visitors enjoy a sense of its history when they sample local food at the store's casual dining area on the lanai, purchase field-ripened pineapples, sundry items, merchandise with Kapalua's butterfly-logo and other Hawaiian gifts.

HISTORY:

- Over the years, it has undergone many renovations, but the exterior façade is similar to when it first opened. Located across from the Ranch Office, the Honolua Store was the center of the plantation village.
- Not only was it the "company store," stocking goods and merchandise for purchase by plantation workers, it provided a "Town Center" for the village residents. A bulletin board displayed notices of activities and events; pineapple workers could check the times for starting their field shifts and read labor union notices.
- The area fronting the store was the gathering point for Boy Scouts & Girl Scouts parades, May Day festivities and other social events.

RENOVATIONS: Renovations began in the spring of 2007.

Timeline:

- Expansion of kitchen-scheduled to open December of '07
- Grocery and retail renovation-scheduled to open Spring '08
- Grand Opening-anticipated in Spring of '08

AMENITIES: After renovations, it will offer additional amenities that include a dinner service with dinner take-out, coffee bar and an expanded cold deli. The store will increase its wines selection and feature a variety of gourmet foods and organic health foods that will include pizza freshly baked in a special pizza oven and pineapple smoothies.
